People have a natural desire for exploration, and this program works to harness curiosity through an interactive and engaging experience that provides each participant with a “road map” to that exploration.

### Animal Matrix:

The Animal Matrix facilitation process is a thought provoking experiential tool used to examine personality types that exist within a group or organization. This valuable program identifies and explores personal leadership preferences and discovers how our personal traits work with others.

Creating the ultimate school climate is a process, not a product. We work closely with local school districts and educational communities to nurture a culture that welcomes all team members, explores the importance of social and emotional learning, and challenges members to build strong relationships, character traits and life skills.
