2021 SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

2021 will see us doing two fundraising events, and there are sponsorship opportunities with both. The Golf Benefit raises dollars to support summer camp and in more recent years - the Camp Daggett Adventure Center (CDAC). The following are the sponsorship opportunities for the golf benefit:

Title Sponsorship (1 available) \$5,000.00

CAMP DAGGETT FACTS

For 96 years Camp Daggett's primary focus has been on youth development. Our programs stand behind our mission to provide quality character building experiences for young people through recreational and educational activities. Since the beginning, there have been many changes made at Camp Daggett, however, the primary emphasis has always remained on youth. Camp Daggett has become more than a summer camp. Programming has evolved to meet the needs of youth and adults on a year-round basis through the Camp Daggett Adventure Center (CDAC). Scholarship support is needed for both summer camp campers and for youth to participate in CDAC programs.

In past years over \$566,000 has been raised by the Golf Benefit. During that same time \$339,000 in scholarships were given to 1,172 summer campers. In the past 7 years close to \$125,000 has been given in CDAC scholarships; many of these to area schools so their students could participate in CDAC programs. Since its inception CDAC has worked with over 155,000 participants.

We are working very hard to ensure that future generations of youth will always have a place to enjoy the innocence of childhood; where life moves at a slower pace and young people can take time to just be kids without the distraction of digital devices. The character-building experiences children take away from Camp Daggett through both summer camp and CDAC programs are invaluable and will remain with them as they journey through life.

Thank you to all who have participated in the past by playing golf, attending dinner or purchasing something in one of our auctions. We hope you will join us again this year.
