Director – Camp Daggett Adventure Education – Northern Lower Michigan

Camp Daggett is hiring a full-time, year-round director for our Camp Daggett Adventure Education program. We wish to fill this position immediately; however, we are patient enough to wait until the right candidate is identified.

Camp Daggett is a year-round, non-profit organization located on Walloon Lake near Petoskey, MI in the northwest lower peninsula of Michigan. Established in 1925, Camp Daggett has various program components including traditional coed youth summer camp sessions, lodge rental and group facilities usage and our adventure/experiential/wilderness education programs through our Camp Daggett Adventure Center (CDAC).

POSTION OVERVIEW: Camp Daggett incorporates adventure education into the majority of its programs. As part of the program team, this position focuses on structured teambuilding, wilderness adventure trips, and managing the challenge course—including outdoor low and high ropes elements as well as an indoor high ropes course.

The Director leads these content areas and collaborates with the Camp Daggett Program Team on all program delivery for corporate and school groups, summer camp, wilderness trips, probate programs and other special events.

Programs are delivered by the program team and adventure education staff—who are trained part-time, “on-call” individuals.

Currently the year-round program includes corporate and school groups, summer camp, wilderness trips, probate programs and other special events. The Camp Daggett Adventure Education Program has grown and been successful since 1998 when we hired our first Adventure Education Director. We are looking for the right individual that can help guide the program into the future.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor’s Degree (minimum)
- Education/training in areas such as:
 - Adventure education and/or experiential education
 - Human focused leadership training and/or Other related fields that relate to leadership development
- Previous experience in leading teambuilding activities, wilderness camping and activities as well as a love/appreciation of the outdoors
- Challenge Course Level 1 Certification or similar, or willingness/ability to obtain
- First Aid and CPR certification, or willingness/ability to obtain
- Wilderness First Responder and Lifeguard Certification, or willingness/ability to obtain
- Ability and willingness to learn new skills and grow professionally in the adventure education field
